



PROFICIENCY TRAINING PROCESS AND WHAT TO KNOW

1. Visit us at our premises.
2. Select the type of training you are interested in (Handgun, manually operated rifle, self-loading rifle, Shotgun).
3. Purchase the manuals for the firearm training.
4. You will receive your manuals and the available class dates.
5. Take the manuals home and self-study.
6. The manuals include formative assessments (open-book exams) that you must complete in black pen before coming to class.
7. The class will be a full day of training.
8. On the day of class you will write the summative assessment (close book exam) first on the knowledge of the firearm control act (if you selected this unit standard).
9. You will then receive a lecture on the firearm/s that you enrolled in.
10. After the lecture, you will write your summative assessment on the firearm/s; the Instructor will then mark the assessments. (pass rate is 80%).
11. You will receive a light lunch.
12. After lunch, you will then proceed to do the firearm exercise assessment and then proceed to do the practical assessment in our shooting range with the firearms, the pass rate for practical assessment is 100%
13. Once you are found competent, you will receive your proficiency certificates within a day or two.

Once you receive your certificates, you can submit your competency application at SAPS.
